- 2. Minutes of the last meeting:
- a. Cridford Inn: successful application to maintain status as an Asset of Community Value.
- b. Teign Valley Road cyclists- carried over.
- c. **Traffic through the village** following the example of other Valley villages, Lucy to invite village children to design traffic calming signs, which can then be printed and displayed at strategic points.
- d. Proposed urban clearway at Haldon- carried over.
- e. Noticeboard relocation carried over.
- f. **Playpark**: New bark has been spread, ROSPA inspection completed, remedial work to be completed.

- 3. **Broadband Scheme:** Due to delays in response from OpenReach, we have missed the deadline to apply for the Gigabit Voucher Scheme. Criteria now changed, Trusham is not eligible for next scheme as upgraded broadband connection scheduled by 2026. Simon to contact interested parties and await Open Reach's proposal for broadband services to the area.

- c. **Mareden** a derelict property near Trenchford reservoir has recently been sold by South West Water. It had been owned by Trusham Parish until the mid 19<sup>th</sup> century.
- d. **Landslip** and wall collapse on the corner of Trusham Hill & Teign Valley Road may be repaired this summer might result in a road closure
