1. Matters arising:

- i. Gravel between steps on Footpath 1 – c/fwd.

- iii. Devon Assn Local Council fee of £24.59 had been paid.
- iv. The Aon insurance fee had been renegotiated to £234.50 – this had been paid.
- v. The open gardens and cream teas had raised £120.07 for village funds – thanks to everyone who opened their gardens and provided the teas.

3. Planning Applications:

- ii. Application on behalf of Mr T Burling at Sunnymead for 2 storey and single storey extension.
- iii. It was understood that planning permission may be needed to open up the green lane next to Silver Birches

4. Footpaths:

Annual parish path partnership meeting will be held on 14th October. Daj to attend.
A bill for £121 had been received from Phil Brooks for strimming Footpaths 1 and 4 (Rydon and Blackley).

5. Treasurers Report:

After costs of £121 for strimming, £324 for hedge cutting, £648 for 3 picnic tables, insurance of £234.50, there was £1,952.52 in the bank.
The audit of the accounts had been carried out and approved.

6. Any Other Business:

- i. Potholes were still appearing (particularly in Church Lane and Broadway). When informing TDC of these, it would be helpful to also inform Cllr. Stephen Purser should he be needed to chase work up.
