

Minutes Trusham Village Meeting

1. **Apologies:** Sarah Maybin; Lucy Otton

2. **Minutes of last meeting:**

a. Neighbourhood Watch – Ian to lead

b. Cridford Inn as an Asset of Community Value- decision by TDC due by 25th March – owners have 8 weeks to appeal

c. Teign Valley Road cyclists - letter received from DCC advising process to introduce speed restrictions. Ali to ask if other Valley villages would want to get involved. DCC may consider loaning cameras to cyclists to report poor driving (trailing in Exeter)

d. Traffic through the village: Simon B to follow up enquiry to DCC councillor re. traffic calming measures and to request another wooden man and “20’s plenty” sign. Paul to look at other possible sites for signage.

e. Parking at Haldon - letter received from Forestry England advising no decrease to parking charges to be considered. AC to request update on Urban Clearway Order from DCC.

f. Noticeboard - Ali to arrange contractor to re-site, DCC have approved

g. Flooding: Ali to report flooding on road near Coombeshead Farm to DCC

3. **Broadband Scheme:** Simon B reported back on the Gigabit Voucher Scheme. He is in contact with the Rural Engagement Manager at BT and will continue efforts to get a response to his application in time to meet the deadline.

4. **Playpark:** Bark to be delivered w/b 15th February. Lucy will monitor the condition of the playpark equipment and play area on going. Phil Brooks is completing remedial work before the ROSPA inspection in March.

5. **Events:** No plans. Ability to use Zoom account for meetings is now shared with the church and can be used by others as a community facility.

6. **Finance:** Balance £3040.13 Community fund balance: £4053.92

7. **AGM:** Postponed. Ali to email village with list of committee members, inviting queries or concerns to discuss, as there will be no AGM while Covid restrictions are in place.

a. Pat to email village re. reporting potholes with link to Devon Highways.

b. Suggestion had been received from resident that CCTV cameras be placed at either end of village following recent fly-tipping and suspicious vehicle activity. Committee felt that living with cameras monitoring them is not in the spirit of village life. Ian Stone advised that installation of equipment and subsequent viewing of images is very difficult given data & privacy legislation and therefore unlikely to be of significant use
