

Trusham National Register 1939

December 1938 it was agreed that in event of war, a National Register would be taken, listing details of every civilian. This would be used to coordinate the war effort, issue identity cards, to organise rationing etc. September 1st, 1939 Germany invaded Poland; two days later Britain declared war on Germany. The National Registration Act received royal assent on September 5th. National Registration Day took place on September 29

Forms were issued to be filled in for over 41 million people; enumerators visited every household collecting names, addresses, marital status, occupation. This enabled the immediate issuing of identity cards. The completed Register was used after the war to assist the founding of the NHS in 1948. Military personnel would have been called to duty by the time of the Register, so will not appear at their home address.
